Timberline Ranch Statement of Faith

All those who participate in the ministry of Timberline must demonstrate agreement with the statement of faith as it is outlined in the bylaws of the society:

We believe in God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; in the verbal inspiration of the Holy Scriptures as originally given; in the vicarious atonement of the Lord Jesus Christ and the eternal salvation of all who believe in Him and the eternal punishment of all who reject Him.

1. Jesus Christ is the Son of God and therefore Lord (Colossians 1:15-20). He is the exact image of God (Hebrews 1:3). He was fully God and fully man (Philippians 2:6-9).
2. The Bible is the Word of God and therefore our final authority (2 Timothy 3:16). The Word of God is living and abiding, crossing time and cultures (1 Peter 1:23).
3. The grace of God is sovereign. All ministry must originate with Him. All increase comes from Him. The prayer of faith appropriates His promises. The response of faith obeys His commands (Matthew 15:13; Romans 4:20,21; Romans 12:1-3; 1 Corinthians 3:6-7; Romans 4:16).
4. Christians are all members of the Body of Christ and therefore our gifts should be used to benefit the Body of Christ (Romans 12:4-5; 1 Corinthians 12:12-28; Ephesians 4:4-6; Ephesians 4:25).
5. Christ seeks excellence. As representatives of Christ, we should do all things well for His glory (Deuteronomy 4:6-9; 1 Peter 2:11,12; Colossians 3:23; 1 Corinthians 9:25-27).
