- A tax-free bursary is paid to the SWAT member's school by the end of the summer
- The bursary amount for 2012 is **\$2300** for the entire summer
- The SWAT member may raise an additional **\$1700**, which must be received by July 31.
- Any SWAT member who chooses not to attend school in the fall forfeits the entire amount of their bursary, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Executive Director.

Please note: SWAT applications are due by February 29, 2012. Applications received after this date will only be considered if the needs of the Ranch cannot be fulfilled by the applications on hand by February 29.
